We, from the Secretariat of International Relations of the National Confederation of Metalworkers affiliated to the Central Unica dos Trabalhadores (SRI CNM-CUT), Brazilian representatives in the World Employees Committee at Daimler (WEC) and Coordinator of the Network of Workers in Mercedes Benz do Brazil affiliated to CNM-CUT, we support the movement that started last March 12, where 29,000 workers in the factories in Baden Württemberg made a warning stop, leaving their jobs between 2 and 3 hours earlier to sensitize employers to negotiate the agenda of the working class that claim in their Collective Bargaining the minimum of economic and social counterparts to go through this delicate moment of world sanitary emergency.
